SESSION 1

Creeker Camp - entering 1st - 5th grades

Outdoor Explorers - June 21 - July 2

Attention all explorers! If you enjoy spending time outside and exploring nature, then this is the camp for you. Join us for scavenger hunts, nature hikes, rock wall climbing, as well as learning survival skills such as using a compass and map. We will spend our days exploring nature and observing the world around us!

All Stars - July 6* - 16

Calling all team players and game fanatics! Campers will spend two weeks learning a variety of both indoor and outdoor games. All games will emphasize the importance of teamwork and good sportsmanship. The final days of our camp will be marked with an Indian Creek Olympics that gives everyone a chance to contribute to their team.

Science Wizards - July 19 - 30

Do you like getting messy? Do you ever wonder how things work? We will explore the scientific mysteries around us through experiments, art, and games. Scientists of all ages will be sure to have a great time!

Broadway Bound, Counselor Understudy, Behind the Scenes, Rising Stars Upper School Campus June 21 - July 30

Broadway Bound - June 21 - July 16

Broadway Bound is a four week camp for students interested in musical theater on stage and behind the scenes. The experience provides an opportunity to perform along with the camaraderie that comes from creating a production from start to finish. Campers entering grades 1-6 form the chorus for our show. Each group is featured in a song and participates in the group songs. The chorus is the place if you love to sing and dance.

Counselor Understudy - June 21 - July 16

Students audition for and play many of the main roles in our BB production. They participate in classes alongside the BB Chorus members. "Understudies" also help counselors and assume more responsibilities. These added responsibilities prepare them for future years when they may wish to return as counselors. Students entering grades 7 - 10 (under age 16)

Behind the Scenes - June 21 - July 16

Students learn the backstage magic of a production. They apply their knowledge to building sets and running the lights and sounds. Be ready to lend a hand and get dirty as the backbone of our BB production. Students entering grades 5 -10 (under age 16)

Rising Stars - July 19 - 30

Here's a new opportunity for students *entering first grade through fifteen years old*. This camp features work on singing, dancing, acting, and drama. Each day campers will work on these skills and practice for a Broadway review featuring all our campers. Campers will "play the main roles" in scenes and songs. Each age group will work on its own portion of the production and will be part of the creative process as we decide what will happen during their song and scene. They'll enjoy the excitement as they learn more about their skills and being a star!
